Directions for use:	
Preparation:	The foundation must be clean, dry, solid, non-smudging and free from wall-paper remnants.
	Non-absorbent and painted foundations are sanded and washed with a cleaning agent. Especially when hanging non-absorbent coverings, it is important that the foundation is absorbent.
	On smudging or very absorbent surfaces must be primed with Plaster Primer 224 or Plaster Primer Gel Extra 228 after cleaning.
Dilution:	The adhesive is stirred well before use. If necessary, the adhesive can be diluted with water.
Application temperature:	15 °C to 30 °C, best at room temperature.
Application:	<i>Mounting of fibre glass web and fibre glass felt.</i> The adhesive is applied in an even layer to the wall, using brush, roller or spray application. Do not apply adhesive on a large area than the material can be mounted while the adhesive is still wet.
	Mounting of foamed wallpaper: The adhesive is applied in an even layer on the back side of the wallpaper, where it must soften the paper before mounting. Avoid adhesive in the front side of wallpaper, any glue that comes to the front, removed depending on paper quality with a damp cloth or sponge.
	Always avoid adhesive on the front of the wall covering material.
