DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278

The carpet lays as bonded, but it can be removed again

General description and application:

DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 is a water-based adhesive for fixation of carpets/carpet tiles with foam, filt- or rubber backside.

DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 keeps the carpet in place, so lumps and creases are avoided. The carpet lies as bonded but is easy to remove without destroying the sub floor.

DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 replaces double bonding tape or loose laying carpets and gives a better result.

Can be used on both new and old floors, on absorbent and dense substrates such as e.g. self-levelling concrete, chip boards, wood fibre boards, plywood on parquet- or wooden floor as well as on linoleum floors

DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 meets the requirements of Emicode Class EC 1.

Directions for use:

Preparation: The sub floor should be clean, dry and even.

Application: DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 is applied with a paint roller. On a very absorbent surface it can

be necessary to apply adhesive twice or use a Primer 600 as the first layer.

When curing the adhesive turns transparent, and then the carpet-/carpet tiles can be

mounted.

Application temperature: Room temperature at minimum $+15^{\circ}$ C.

The curing time is at +23°C and 55% RF approx. 30-40 min.

The curing time depends on the temperature, humidity, absorbent, and non-absorbent

surfaces.

Remember to rub the covering well into the adhesive.

When laying carpet tiles with a felt backside subsequently rolling Is always recommended.

Yield: 6 - 12 *m*²/litre.

Removing: When the carpet/tiles later must be removed, the carpet is loosened in the one corner and

slowly pulled of. The strength of DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 is normally weaker than the

backside of the carpet.

On old carpets and certain carpets with an unstable backside, can it accur that the foam on the backside of the carpet is torn apart. If there are small pieces of carpet left on the floor, the floor is washed with hot water and soap. After approx. 10 - 15 min. the rest of the foam can

be rubbed or scraped of.

DanAtac Carpet Fixation 278 cannot be washed off, but must be removed mechanically. When cleaning wood- and parquet floors sanding and surface treatment must be expected. If the floor does not withstand the influence of water the rest of the carpets can be removed

with ethanol or white spirit, but please test before use, so that the surface will not be

damaged by this treatment.

Cleaning: Stains of adhesive is removed straight away with a wet cloth.

Adhesive on the skin is removed by washing with water and soap.

Tools are cleaned with water while the adhesive is still wet.
